

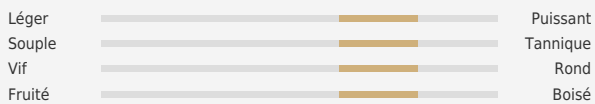


CHÂTEAU DESMIRAIL

PRODUIT

Château Desmirail (Margaux, Third Grand Cru Classé 1855) seduces with its deep garnet color and elegant balance of ripe black fruits, refined spices, subtle minerality, and earthy notes typical of the Médoc. James Suckling awards it 92/100, highlighting its earthy nose of blackberries, bark, oyster shells, and cloves, with subtle tannins. Wine Spectator also awards it 92/100, highlighting its accents of lilac, candied blackcurrant, and incense, supported by a touch of minerality and spice. Robert Parker rates the 2018 vintage at 89, appreciating its aromas of candied cherries, simmered black fruits, sautéed herbs, mint, and anise, with a rich, finely tannic finish.
