

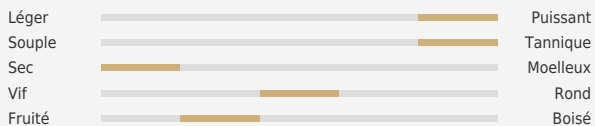


HERMITAGE "LA CHAPELLE" 3 L

The vines, aged between 40 and 95 years, are cultivated using stakes, a traditional method that allows for optimal aeration of the grape clusters. Its aging potential and evolving aromas make it an ideal choice for lovers of great wines.
