

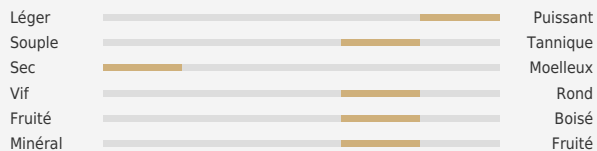


HERMITAGE "LA CHAPELLE"

PRODUIT

The 2011 Hermitage “La Chapelle” by Paul Jaboulet Aîné is a legendary cuvée from the northern Rhône Valley, sourced from prestigious plots such as Le Méal, Les Bessards and Les Rocoules, which benefit from deep granite soils and optimal exposure. This 100% Syrah wine, aged in oak for approximately 15 to 18 months, reveals an intense ruby color with slightly purple highlights. The nose expresses a great aromatic complexity combining ripe black fruits (plum, blackberry), sandalwood, licorice, peppery herbs and smoky notes, accompanied by a mineral undertone. On the palate, the attack is ample, the tannins are firm but melted, the mid-palate dense, and the finish long carried by a remarkable mineral freshness that prolongs the pleasure. This wine has excellent aging potential, still capable of evolving for several years, and pairs majestically with game dishes, red meat in sauce or rich gourmet cuisine.
