PRODUIT

As the label already suggests, Camins del Priorat is a wine for lovers of beauty and pleasant aromas. It presents itself as the entry-level wine from Alvaro Palacios' winery, but it boasts a character all its own.

This wine comes from small vineyard plots—all located in the appellation's five best municipalities—(Gratallops, Porrera, Torroja, La Vilella Alta and La Vilella Baixa, Bellmunt, El Molar, El Lloar, and Poboleda), at different altitudes and exposures, with vines of varying ages (between 10 and 40 years old).

Camins del Priorat is made primarily from native grape varieties (50% Grenache and 15% Cariñena), complemented by Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, and Merlot.
