



MARANGES 1ER CRU

PRODUIT

South of the Côte de Beaune, the *Maranges 1er Cru* appellation of Joseph Drouhin produces powerful and elegant red wines from terroirs with rich clay-limestone soils. This wine seduces with an intense nose of black fruits, black cherry, and plum, punctuated by spicy and lightly toasted notes. On the palate, it offers a beautiful tannic structure, combined with a pleasant freshness and a long, balanced finish. Traditional vinification, followed by careful aging in oak barrels, highlights the aromatic complexity while respecting the purity of the Pinot Noir. A perfect accompaniment to game, red meats, or dishes in sauce, this Maranges 1er Cru combines character and finesse for an authentic tasting experience.
