Presentation

The Branco de Telmo Rodríguez in Valdeorras perfectly embodies the winemaker's commitment to indigenous grape varieties and high-altitude terroirs. Made from **Godello**, Galicia's emblematic grape variety, this white wine comes from vines grown on granite slopes in the Sil Valley, in the Valdeorras appellation. Telmo Rodríguez, a key figure in the Spanish wine revival, produces a wine of great purity, respectful of its environment, with minimal interventionist vinification that highlights the unique character of this Atlantic terroir.

Tasting

To the eye, a pale yellow color with brilliant highlights. The nose reveals beautiful complexity, blending **white flowers, juicy pear, fresh citrus, and mineral notes** reminiscent of warm stone. On the palate, the wine seduces with its **lively freshness**, its ample texture and its **precise balance** between roundness and tension. The finish is long, saline, with a slight iodine touch that calls to mind seafood. A white with character, both accessible and elegant, perfect to accompany grilled fish, seafood or subtly perfumed Mediterranean cuisine.
